“The Worship of the Church”

Not only has God ordained the organization of the church, He has also ordained the worship of the church. Christ, in John 4:23-24, set forth that our worship is to be directed to the Father and is to be done in spirit (the proper attitude) and in truth (according to the Scriptures). In the Scriptures, God has ordained five items we are to participate in. We are to engage in prayer (Acts 2:42; 1 Cor. 14:15; 1 The. 5:17). We are to contribute of our money to the Lord (1 Cor. 16:1-2; 2 Cor. 8:1-9). We are to study God’s Word (Acts 2:42; 20:7; 1 Cor. 15:1-15). While these three are virtually universally accepted, there are differing views on the last two, but we must allow the Bible to be our final guide. The Scriptures set forth that we are to partake of the Lord’s Supper on each first day of the week (11:17-34; Acts 2:42; 20:7). Thus it is to be a weekly observance done on Sunday—the first day of the week, and not done only monthly, quarterly, yearly, etc. And then there is to be the singing of praises to God. This is set forth in passages such as 1 Corinthians 14:15, Colossians 3:15, and James 5:13. All passages in the New Testament (that which we are under today) specifically mention singing; never is it to make music. That excludes adding any instrument of music to that singing, for that would be adding to God’s Word which is condemned (Rev. 22:18). God specifies in Ephesians 5:19 that the instrument is to be the heart: “Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord.” If your worship is different, then it must be after the commandment of men. “But in vain they do worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men” (Mat. 15:9).
